How to Register

- The registration headquarters are in the Alumni Library, situated on the south side of the campus.
- Appear at the Library upon arriving in Oxford and get a time card which indicates the time at which you are to return and register for the year.
- 3. Return to the Library at the time indicated upon the time card. Then, if you have not decided upon your course, you will be given necessary instruction regarding the courses offered. At this time arrange for the payment of all fees.
- While waiting for your turn to register, all arrangements should be made for rooms. This can also be attended to in the Library.
- 5. It is advisable, when possible, for all new students to make arrangements with the Deans concerning their course and their rooms.
- 6. Women students are asked to acquaint themselves as soon as possible with the regulations for their college life suggested by the Student Government Organization. These regulations are posted in the halls of residence and in all cottages in the town where women students are housed.

Some Hints on How to Study

Many students come to college Not Knowing How to Study. As a result, they waste considerable time and energy, many get very low grades, and some fail entirely. Study is Largely Habit. Correct study means correct methods of procedure and application. Economy of time and energy is the result. Nothing is more important to the college student. Therefore start right, begin immediately upon entrance to college to form good habits of study.

These hints may aid you to be a Better Student.

- 1 Have a Definite Time to study. Study the same subject at the same time each day. Make a Schedule of Study to correspond to your schedule of recitations.
- 2 Work when you work. Don't mix work and play. Begin and end your work promptly. Get Down to Business Immediately.
- 3 Apply yourself Diligently for Short Periods, then rest. Concentrate all your energy on the work at hand until you begin to tire, then Rest,—do something different. After a short period of rest resume your work.
- 4 Read the Entire Lesson thru at first. Determine now the main problem or topic of the lesson. Get a big viewpoint.
- 5 Second, separate the Essential from the Non-Essential. The secret of study is knowing What to Omit. Books are filled with details and repetitions. Find the Elephants.

- 6 Underlining Important Sentences in your texts is valuable and saves time in review. The better practice is to write out the essentials in a Note Book.
- 7 Learn the important facts or principles (1) by simply recalling them, (2) by asking yourself questions bearing on the lesson and answering them in reference to the principles or facts as hand, (3) by applying these new facts and principles to your previous knowledge or experience.
- 8 Ideas must be systematized. Isolated Facts in consciousness have No Power to function. Make each New Idea a Part of Yourself. Relate it or connect it to something you already know. Unify Your Mental Content.
- 9 Do Not Cram. It has no permanent value. Review the essential often. Begin your study with a review of previous lessons and end your study with a review of the present lesson. Review Makes Knowledge Permanent.

The Arion Choir is a chorus of picked voices organized by the Department of Music. It consists of approximately a hundred mixed voices, and gives an annual spring concert, at which some noted opera, oratorio, or other large musical work is produced.

Literary Societies

The University maintains two debating teams which carry out each year a schedule of several intercollegiate debates.
